**Whereas:** A recent study has shown that there is a high level of distrust

between students and the Oxford Police and, through the Good Neighbor Policy mediations, between community residents and

students exaggerating both real and perceived strains on relationships between permanent residents and students;

**Therefore be it resolved:** Miami University Associated Student Government

will hold biennial ASG Days of Service no later than the first Sunday in October and on any given Sunday

in March;

**Further it be resolved:** This program will be mandatory for all Senators and

highly recommended for all other members of the

Associated Student Government, with Senators being encouraged to invite their constituents to join;

The Secretary for Off-Campus Affairs will organize the event in partnership with the Office of Community Engagement and Service and the Office of Off-Campus Outreach, which will serve in an advisory role to the Secretary.
